(Software Value Added Reseller)

MANDATORY FOR STATE AGENCIES AVAILABLE TO POLITICAL SUBDIVISIONS

The NASPO ValuePoint (formerly WSCA-NASPO) cooperative purchasing organization has established contracts for state agencies and political subdivisions to purchase *Commercial off-the-shelf (COTS)* software licenses, basic installation, training, and maintenance. It does not include consulting services or customizable software that requires design, development, or installation services.

^{*}Insight has acquired En-Pointe and En-Pointe's master agreement will be expiring on April 7, 2020. Any agencies utilizing En-Pointe should now use Insight instead.

Contract Term: April 8, 2016 through March 31, 2023.

Agencies can use these contracts to purchase COTS software licenses and maintenance. For executive branch state agencies, Microsoft Enterprise Agreement (EA) products and Adobe products can only be purchased through SHI. Either reseller can help you determine if your order includes Microsoft EA products.

Off-Contract Items: The websites for these companies may feature hardware and services that are not included in this contract. Those items are provided for marketing purposes only but can be purchased by using regular state procurement procedures. **Remember, this contract is for COTS software licenses and maintenance regardless of what is available on the vendor website.**

Mandatory Rule: Executive branch agencies are required to purchase all of their COTS software from these contracts, including for the following key publishers:

Microsoft, Adobe, Citrix, Novell, Symantec, and VMWare.

Exceptions to the Mandatory Rule: Outside of the key publishers listed above, an agency may go off contract if they can find a cheaper price elsewhere and give at least two of the resellers a chance to provide a quote, or if the order exceeds \$100,000, the agency may conduct a competitive solicitation or use other procurement methods if applicable such as single source or limited competition.
