# Creating FDs in IRIS

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### Introduction

An FD is used to remove property from the IRIS active register. An FD can be utilized when approval is given by the Property Management Office (PMO) via an ETARS to discard broken or unserviceable property by Departments. Or in some cases to remove property from the active registry in IRIS that was accidently entered or no longer needs to be tracked due to regulatory changes.
